### Title to Kelly

>> Canterbury lawn bowler Andrew Kelly capped off a magnificent tournament by winning his last two matches in straight sets to claim his first World Junior Cup title, in Australia this week. The 22-year-old Elmwood player went through the 1/2-round event unbeaten conceding just three sets. Already a member of New Zealand's senior squad, the Black Jacks, Kelly completed his rout in Warilla, New South Wales, by thrashing Pierre Breitenbach of South Africa 13-1, 10-3 and then Iqbal Hassan of the UAE 14-3, 11-6. Kelly also won the silver medal in the triples with Andrew Todd and Richard Girvan, at the recent Eight-Nations event in India.
