A new and original game of bowls for 3 players, based on Singles.
An exciting-Fun, competitive-relaxing-not too serious-different game!
A chance to polish your singles skills.

Tournament Format (in 2 parts)

Part A

- Players will be drawn and divided into divisions of 9 which are then divided into sections of three. Play on a round-robin basis.
- Each plays 2 two short games and marks one.
- Target score of 11 points or 35 minutes, whichever is first. Surplus points earned on the last end are added to players total.
- Players change rinks after each game.

Part B

- Three play-off groups. 1st 2nd 3rd.
- Target score of 11 points or 30 minutes, whichever is first.
- Winners of these sections will each receive a prize.

Summary

- Every player plays four bowls.
- The 1st Marker and Players are advised to have 2 trial ends before play begins on their opening rink.
- The player who wins the toss may decide to play with 1 mat or 2.
- Incorrect Jack delivery, marker places Jack at opponent's choice.
- 'Killed end' Jack placed on 2 metre mark.
- Players can only approach the head after the last bowl.
- Section placings will be decided on wins, draws, net differentials then ends won. Draws count. Wins = 2, Draws = 1.
- Play on a monthly basis. Players must find own replacement.

One player in three will win a prize in each tournament! All scores collated. Points winner receives a trophy on closing day. Therefore N.B. this tournament is also a seasonal competition!! Open to all financial Club members. **\$5 entry fee**
